# STATE CROSS COUNTRY QUALIFIERS Classes 2A, 3A, 4A, 5A, 6A 

- Top three (3) teams from each regional.
- Top ten (10) individuals, if there are not five (5) from non-qualifying teams use the procedure below to determine additional runners:


## CRITERIA to Qualify for State - Classes 2-6A

A. Three (3) top teams from each regional ( $3 \times 4$ Regionals $=12$ teams $\times 7$ runners)
B. Top ten (10) runners medal and qualify for State.

1) Many of these runners may well be members of a qualifying team!
2) Once the top ten individual runners have been identified. THEN
C. Review and count those runners in top 10 who are not members of a qualifying team.
D. IF "only 1 of the top ten runners" is from a non-qualifying team, identify the next four runners also not a member of the top three (state qualifying) teams.
E. IF "2 of the top ten runners" are from non-qualifying teams, identify the next three runners also not members of top three (state qualifying) teams.
F. IF "3 of the top ten runners" are from non-qualifying teams, identify the next two runners also not members of top three (state qualifying) teams.
G. IF "4 of the top ten runners" are from non-qualifying teams, identify the one runner from a nonqualifying team - this runner will then also qualify for state.

Do Not take any other finisher until A, B, C and (D-G) are checked.

- In the possible but unlikely event that runners from the qualifying teams finish 1-21 (7 runners $\mathbf{x} 3$ teams), it would then be the meet manager's responsibility to identify the top five (5) individuals from non-qualifying teams from runners who finished in $\mathbf{2 2 ^ { \text { nd } }}$ place or lower.
- It is also possible that five (5) or more individual runners from non-qualifying teams will finish in the top ten. In this situation, there would be no additional runners identified from non-qualifying teams.


## The following outline of qualifying criteria is provided to ensure:

1. no mistakes
2. no misidentification of runners
3. no confusion on the part of Regional Meet Managers
4. no unhappy participants, parents, \& coaches
5. the proper qualifying individuals are so advised at the conclusion of regionals
6. State Managers receive only correct information
