Location: Lexington Lake Park, 9000 Sunflower Rd, De Soto, KS 66018

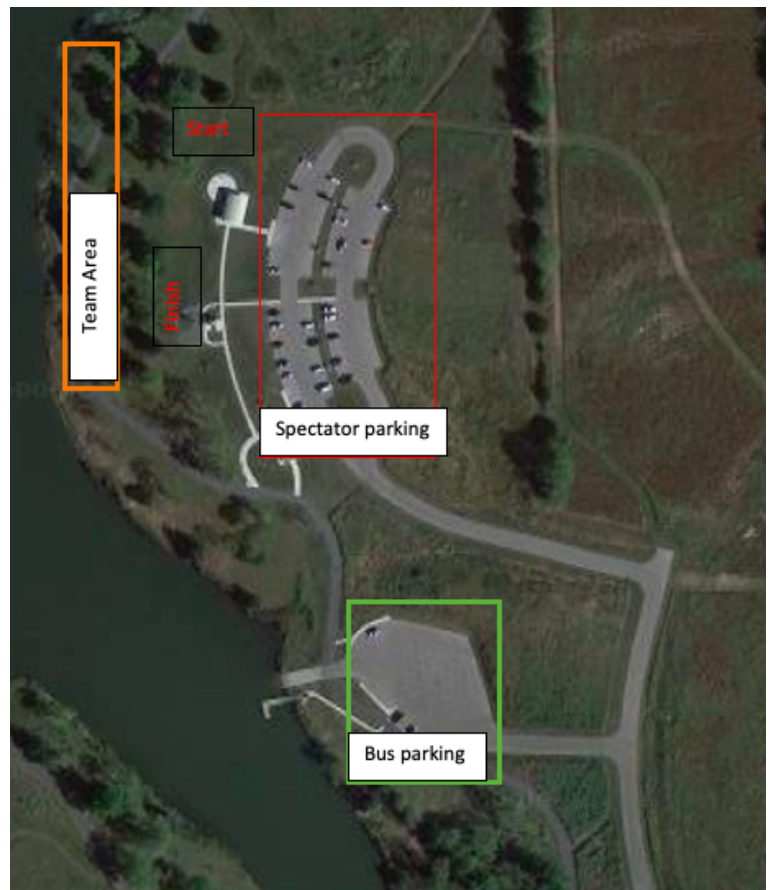
Directions: There is a lot of construction around De Soto and on K-10. Please allow plenty of travel time. General Directions:

Take the Edgerton Road exit off of K-10
Go South on Edgerton Road to 95th Street
Take 95th Street east to Sunflower Road
Take Sunflower Road north to the park.

Bus parking: Buses must park in the green lot (the first left after entering the park). No buses are allowed in the red lot. Athletes will unload in the bus parking lot, and follow the paved path to the team area.

Spectator parking: Spectators may park in the red-outlined lot or along the main road in the park. Please keep two tires on the road.

Team Tent Areas: Team areas need to be set-up west of the finish chute along the lake, and as far back from the course as possible.



Course Preview: The course can be previewed during normal park hours any day of the week. Final course markings will not be complete until late afternoon on Friday, October 21st.

Course Monitors Provided by Each School: Each school is asked to provide one course monitor per race. This can be the same person or different persons for the girls and boys races. Course monitors need to attend the coaches meeting to receive instructions on their designated location. A course monitor from two different schools will be randomly assigned to course monitor locations. **Coaches—please email the name(s) of your course monitor(s) to Jack Sachse (jsachse@usd232.org) by 5:00pm on Thursday, October 20th.**

Qualifying for the State Meet (from KSHSAA manual):

- **Criteria to Qualify for the State Meet:**

1. Three (3) top teams from each regional.
2. Top ten (10) runners medal and qualify for state.
3. Top five (5) individuals from "non-qualifying teams" if not in top 10.
4. Once the top ten (10) individuals have been identified:

THEN use procedure below to determine if additional runners from non-qualifying teams should be included as state qualifiers.

- A. Review and count those runners in top 10 who are not members of a qualifying team.
- B. If only one (1) of the top 10 runners is from a non-qualifying team, identify the next four runners also not a member of the top three (state qualifying) teams.
- C. If two (2) of the top 10 runners are from non-qualifying teams, identify the next three runners also not members of the top three (state qualifying) teams.
- D. If three (3) of the top 10 runners are from non-qualifying teams, identify the next two runners also not members of the top three (state qualifying) teams.
- E. If four (4) of the top 10 runners are from non-qualifying teams, identify the next one runner not a member of the top three (state qualifying) teams.

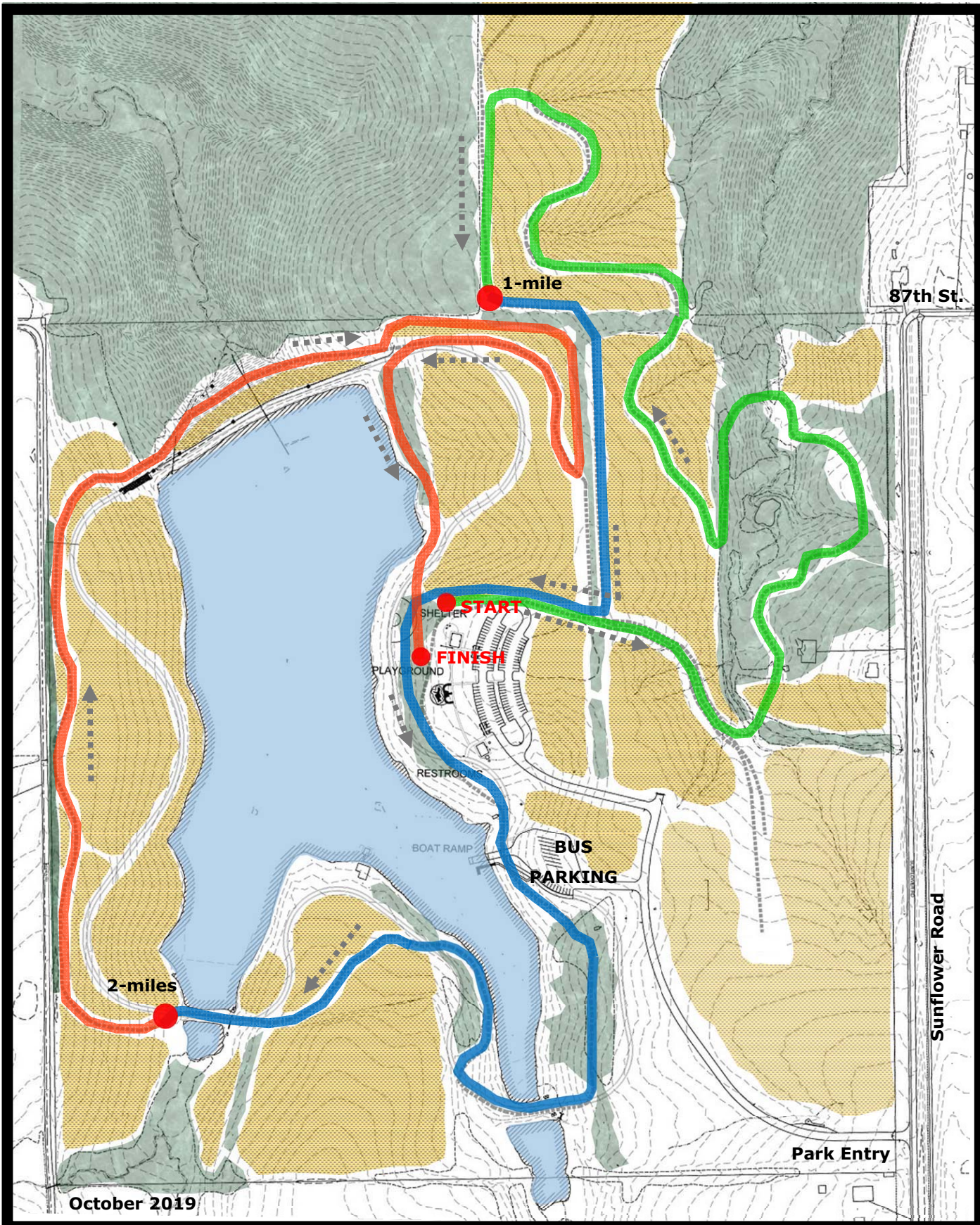
