AWARDS:

7th girls / boys→ Top 15 places per division 8th girls / boys→ Top 15 places per division

HS girls / boys→ Top 30 places per division

All MS medals are awarded at the finish line

Team trophies will be awarded to the top 3 teams in the HS boys race and the top 3 teams in the HS girls race.

CHUTE ASSIGNMENTS: Will be designated at the time of packet pickup.

SCORING: We have hired KC Running Company again this year and will have chip timing.

Please use the chip ties provided and DO NOT have athletes tie the timing chips into their shoes - having to untie shoes causes a delay in the finish line chute. **Please communicate this to your athletes prior to the race**.

Results will be given to coaches before departure if possible and will be emailed within 24 hours. HS races: The top 5 athletes from each team will score points with the 6th and 7th runners being used as a displacer in the event of a tie. Teams do not need to designate the top 7 prior to the race. Any runners after that will be eligible for a medal if they are in the top 30 finishers but not eligible to score points for the team.

Please try to have your entries completed by Tuesday, September 2nd. This will give us ample time to get the entries completed to eliminate complications on race day. Because of the format of our meet, you will not need to designate "varsity" or "JV." Registration info is at the bottom.

EMERGENCY LOCATION: In case of weather or emergency teams will report to their busses and patrons can report to vehicles or Shelter F

T-SHIRTS: Our friends from M&A Designs will be selling T-shirts in a variety of colors so **please encourage your athletes to bring money if they would like a shirt** (design attached.)
